The Extent of Implementing the School's Development Plan from the Point of View of Supervisors

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Abstract--- Educational systems in all Arab countries seek to improve performance, and for this purpose they aim to liberate schools from the hegemony of the central pattern in planning and management, a pattern that has prevailed for decades because of the political and economic conditions in the world. Passed The decentralized approach to school planning and management is consistent with the nature of the transformation that Arab societies have witnessed for a while, especially in our country, Iraq, where the goal has become to expand the area of responsibility in performance evaluation, to see the extent of development in performance and discover glitches so that quick solutions can be found.

I. CHAPTER ONE

Research Problem

Strategic planning is considered one of the modern management concepts, as it is an effective tool to achieve long-term goals, enabling institutions to define their current and future capabilities in a way that guarantees them success in a world characterized by change and continuous complexity, and to identify the reality of educational planning, and to identify the most important problems faced by this sector When applying educational planning tools and mechanisms

Although many countries were very optimistic about the ability of comprehensive planning in general, and administrative in particular, to achieve goals that cannot be reached without it. Accordingly, the research problem may lie through surveying information from a group of supervisors about the schools 'ability to understand and apply quality assurance standards (the development plan) showing a clear weakness of these standards. What is the extent of applying the development plan in schools from the point of view of supervisors?

Therefore, in order for the planning process to succeed, a strategy must be defined that includes setting clear goals, prioritizing, providing material and human capabilities, predicting future possibilities and different circumstances, inclusion, realism, flexibility, follow-up, evaluation, and evaluation.

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Importance of the Research

The importance of this study stems from the fact that it is looking at one of the relatively recent administrative issues, which is the development plan and the factors affecting it and its role in increasing the performance of workers, as this concept is considered recent, so subjecting it to field study gives it more importance, especially in light of the various technological, economic and policy conditions and changes, Which requires adopting the concept of planning from an applied perspective to keep pace with the accelerating environmental changes.

Research Objectives

The current research aims to identify the extent of applying the school's development plan from the point of view of the supervisors.

Research hypothesis

There is no statistically significant difference from the arithmetic mean of the supervisors' scores for the measuring instrument and the hypothetical mean at the level of significance (0.05).

Research Limits

- Spatial limit: General Directorate of Education, Baghdad, Karkh 2
- Time limit: 2016-2017
- The substantive limit: The extent to which the school's development plan has been implemented from the point of view of the supervisors.

Defining Terms:

Strategic Planning

It is the process by which a strategy is developed, and includes strategic analysis and selection

And identifying alternatives, and is concerned with finding coherence and consistency between the strategic and interim goals and the short objectives, in a way that ensures that all the efforts scattered are directed towards achieving the personal and long-term goals identified in the best way and costs.

II. CHAPTER TWO

Measures Search

This chapter includes the procedures followed in achieving the goals of the research in terms of defining the research community and its sample, preparing the measurement tool, calculating the honesty with its various indicators, calculating stability and the final application of the measurement tool and extracting results using the appropriate statistical means.

Approach taken in the search

Follow the researcher a n research methodology descriptive, one of the methods of scientific research and moving the researcher by this approach in accordance with the steps the way scientific, and highlights the importance of style descriptive in being the only way possible to study some humanitarian issues as determined by the applied design in any research on according to his problem and objectives ,which seeks to achieve (Obeid and others ,date) (184 - 183 : Jaber Kazim (177 : 1989)

Research community and appointed

The current research community is determined by the supervisors and supervisors of the Second Directorate of Education of Karkh in Baghdad, and they are (213), where the researcher chose 20% of the research community, and thus the research sample reached (43) supervisors and supervisors, and they were chosen in a simple random manner.

Tool measuring

A - Read the literature and previous studies

The researcher has now determined the paragraphs of the development plan measurement tool in its initial form, amounting to (30) paragraphs.

B- The first exploratory study

The researcher randomly chose for (20) supervisors and supervisors next to the second Karkh and distributed them to open a questionnaire asking him to specify the paragraphs that indicate the extent of the application development plan from the point of view of supervisors. Thus, the researcher determined the paragraphs that were obtained through the previous two steps, which amounted to (30) paragraphs, which It will be presented to the experts, as the sample of the survey did not add any additional paragraph to the first survey.

Honesty

The sincerity of the tool one of basic concepts in the field of psychological measurement known honesty as a measuring instrument of what is designed to measure, as it is supposed to measure the tool feature that is designed to measure and another feature other or feature another plus her (Chaib 94 :2009) To check the veracity of the search tool current He has the winnings than calculates the following indicators:

Virtual honesty :face validity

This method is based on the idea of exploring the opinions of rulers. It is stipulated that the specialized judgment must have evaluated the relationship of each paragraph of the measuring tools to the ability or the attribute to be measured, after clarifying the meaning of the attribute or ability in a procedural way (Abdel Rahman, 2008: 201). And to verify the apparent honesty, the researcher reached the study of defining the third domain, and a tool was measured on a group of experts in the field of (educational management, guidance and guidance) and reached (5) experts, to make sure of the following:

- 1. The validity of the paragraphs in measuring the extent of application of the development plan
- 2. Amendment paragraphs that need to be modified
- 3. Delete paragraphs that are not valid for measuring the measured attribute
- 4. Adding what can be added from paragraphs

After calculating the answers of the paragraphs, the following was found:

- 1. The validity of all paragraphs of the measuring instrument, as it obtained 80 % or more of expert opinions
- 2. The experts did not add any paragraphs to the paragraphs of the measuring instrument.

Thus became the number of paragraphs in its final form, which will be statistically analyzed to calculate its discriminatory transactions and sincerity (30) vertebra.

Statistical analysis of paragraphs measurement tool

Paragraph analysis is like a server for building tests, which is the process of testing respondents 'responses to all test items in order to judge the quality of the paragraph, specifically what the individual looks at, which is the difficulty of the paragraph and its discriminatory ability as well as the effectiveness of each alternative Marcins and Lehman (2003: 220) to achieve this, The researcher applied the measurement tool to a sample of (150) supervisors and supervisors randomly chosen from the supervisors and supervisors of Baghdad City to the second directorate of Karkh Education.

One of the most common methods used in psychological scales is to use the two extreme groups and the relationship of the vertebra with the overall score of the measuring instrument to maintain good vertebrae and exclude weak vertebrae. "Anastase" indicated that each paragraph related to an external standard or internal standard is one of the indicators of the homogeneity of the paragraphs and their sincerity and the best internal standard is the total score of the measuring instrument (Anastasi, 1988: 209) The researcher explained that the statistical analysis of the paragraphs by calculating the following indicators:

- 1. The Discriminative Force of Paragraphs.
- 2. The relationship of the paragraph to the total score.

The Discriminatory Power of Paragraphs

A distinction paragraph is one of the important characteristics of plants in analyzing paragraphs, a paragraph that helps determine its ability to distinguish between responders with higher grades and subjects with lower grades (Nabhan 2004: 196) and the calculation of the tool for measuring the strength of differential paragraphs, the researcher using the two extremes where this method requires determining two points A cut in the internal test used, which is the total result of each form of statistical analysis forms, where the total sample of statistical analysis reached (150) supervisors and supervisors, their grades were ranked from the highest degree to the lowest degree, then (41) forms were chosen for the degrees for me And (41) forms from the class The world, and therefore the number of the highest group (41) and the lower group (41) arrived. Therefore, paragraphs for which the calculated T-score was equal to or greater than table value (2,000) were kept at the significance level (05)., 0) as shown in Table (1)

Relationship of the paragraph to the overall degree

Although finding the discriminatory force using the two extremist groups, which is one of the indicators of the sincerity of the building, it may not be a clear picture of the homogeneity of the paragraphs in measuring the behavioral phenomenon, so the researchers adopted the total score of the test itself as a test for the validity of its paragraphs, and this method is summarized by calculating the Pearson correlation coefficient. Between the degree of the paragraph from one side and the total score of the scale of the statistical analysis sample of (150) supervisors and supervisors (Attia, 2010: 92) (Nabhan, 2004: 201). It became clear that the paragraphs were statistically significant at the level of its significance (50, 0), and the degree of freedom (149), as the tabular value reached (0,194) at the level of significance (0.05). Reliability

The concept of the stability of the degrees of the measuring instrument means the extent of its lack of irregular errors in the measurement, i.e. the extent of the measurement of the instrument to the true amount of the attribute that it aims to measure, then the degrees of the scale are fixed Reliable if the tool measures a certain feature in a consistent measure, then stability in this sense means consistency or accuracy in measurement (Allam, 2000: 131) For the purpose of obtaining consistency, the researchers adopted the following method: -

1- Test-Retest

It indicates the degree of consistency of the measurements achieved on the scale from time to time upon reapplication. The stability of the tool means checking the extent to which the degree of each member of the consistency group is approaching at some point in the degree to the same instrument in the event of re-application at another time, and this method is summarized by applying the tool to the members of the research group and waiting for an appropriate period of time then re-application to the group itself and calculating the correlation coefficient between the degrees of individuals in the two application times on the same group and calculating the correlation coefficient between the degrees of individuals in the two application times. The extracted correlation coefficient is called the stability coefficient (Al Shayeb, 2009: 105) as the researchers applied the measurement tool to a sample of (25) supervisors and supervisors who were chosen The way Aphrodisiac and then they re-applied to the same sample after two weeks and then the researchers used the Pearson correlation coefficient D was significant as the calculated value reached (0,81) which is greater than the tabular value of at the level of significance (05, 0) as shown in table (3).

After checking the veracity of the scale by the researchers to study the exploratory fourth sample of (15) and honorable supervisor randomly selected from among the administrators and supervisors of the city of Baghdad - alkrkh the second and put the researcher a n necessary instructions to clarify how to answer the measurement tool included the sample urged the answer to the paragraphs of the scale without Neglecting any answer. The aim of the study was:

- 1. Calculate the time required for an answer.
- 2. Knowing the clarity of the paragraphs for male and female respondents.
- 3. Knowing the clarity of instructions for the supervisors and supervisor's respondents.

The results of the study were positive, as there was no inquiry from the respondents, and the specified time for the answer was (20) minutes, and the supervising supervisors showed a clear understanding of the instructions and paragraphs.

Description tool measurement: researcher A n alternative for each paragraph of the measurement tool which is) satisfying ,do not meet (The degree of measurement tool as follows (2,1) you shall take- :

- 1. Grades for the completed alternative
- 2. Degree for the non-fulfilling alternative

Thus, the total score for the measuring instrument ranged between (33) as the lowest degree and (66) as the highest degree and with a hypothetical mean (45) degrees and as shown in Appendix (1)

Application final instrument of measurement

After the researcher verified the n of sincerity measuring instrument and stability they have applied to the sample application has lasted for five days as it began on Sunday 28 - 2017 / 5 /on Thursday2017 / 6 / 4,

Statistical methods

To extract the results, use the surveyor that the statistical bag) spss (I have used the following statistical methods:

- 1 Pearson correlation coefficient (person relation ship)
- 2 T-test for two samples of equal size (T-Test)
- 3 Altaia test sample and the community

III. CHAPTER THREE

Presentation and discussion of results

This chapter presents the results of the researcher with a goal that was presented in the first chapter using the statistical methods described in the third chapter, which were discussed and interpreted in light of previous studies and the theoretical framework presented in the second chapter and then to reach a set of recommendations and proposals in detail: The research goal: - Knowing the extent of applying a plan Development from the point of view of supervisors, and by checking the following zero hypothesis, there is no statistically significant difference between the average score for supervisors. To verify the validity of the null hypothesis, researcher Tha Al-Ta'i used a test for one sample, and observed the result to reject the zero hypothesis and accept the alternative that states that there is a statistically significant difference between the average of supervisors 'scores and the central hypothesis on a measuring instrument at the level (05, 0), where the value reached The calculated test for T (5,169) is greater than the tabular value (021). 2) The degree of freedom (n - 1) shown in Table (4)
